1.	'And Pray for Him ...' Finish the quotation which is on Patrick Kavanagh's Grave in the graveyard adjacent to the Patrick Kavanagh Centre in Inniskeen.
2.	At the Round Tower in Inniskeen there is a large stone with an Irish Saint carved upon it, can you find it - who is it?
3.	Main Street in Carrickmacross used to be known as 'Castle Street' - but where was the 'castle' that once sat upon it and who built it? <i>Bonus points if you can find out what the castle was called and include some of the names you can read from the walls!</i>
4.	What is the name of the playpark in Lough Muckno, Castleblayney and what kind of creature is it named after?
5.	The spire of St. Peter's Tin Church in Laragh is topped with a weather-vane with a brightly coloured cockerel. Can you identify the bright colour of his combs?
6.	When you're in Monaghan town, look out for a monument with 8 sides and an old water fountain. Look up and you'll see that each side has a capital letter carved on it. The combined letters form a word – what is it?
7.	Go out and enjoy a walk in Rossmore Forest Park near Monaghan town – how many giants can you find in the park and what are their names? <i>Bonus points if you can find out the following – What colour are the toenails of the Giant in the playpark?</i>
8.	What famous fellow will you find sitting up high in the middle of Glaslough Village? <i>Bonus points if you can tell us what he is made from!</i>

9. Bragan/Sliabh Beagh is a natural site of great beauty and importance for wildlife and biodiversity. Can you name some of the plants that grow there?

10. Clones town is home to some fun and colourful murals – have a walk about and tell us how many you spot and what you can see in each of them!
